

3357:13-12-23 Curriculum Review Policy (Curriculum Committee)

- (A) The curriculum of an institution of higher education is the primary responsibility of the faculty of each discipline, and the creation, updating, assessing, and review of the curriculum cannot be delegated. Therefore, the Curriculum Committee at North Central State College is the institutional committee responsible for all matters related to curriculum change. This committee has members from all academic divisions and most of the service departments on campus. However, the chair of the committee must be a faculty member. (North Central State College accepts responsibility for ensuring that community stakeholders are in dialogue with faculty through advisory boards, to ensure alignment between curriculum and stakeholder expectations.)
- (B) The committee is responsible for the review of all proposals for new academic programs or majors; as well as proposals for the creation of new courses, the updating of programs/and or courses, any changes to the syllabi supplement, the grading scale and various other curriculum material as instructed by the CAO. The committee shall review all curriculum and provide recommendations to the CAO who is the final authority for all curriculum matters on campus.
