Aspire is a new scholarship program available to students who have earned their GED, an Adult Diploma or the Adult 22+ Diploma to continue into college.



## Aspire scholarships are awarded to both part-time and full-time students:

- Will pay tuition and general fees for up to 30 credits for a part-time student in a qualified certificate program
- Will pay tuition and general fees up to 62 credits for a full-time student in an associate degree program.
- Students may begin by earning a certificate and then continue their studies toward an associate degree (up to the 62 credits allowed by the Aspire scholarship).

## To qualify for the Aspire scholarships, students:

- Must be residents of Ohio.
- Must a 165+ on GED English or 165+ on GED Math.

**OR**

- Must have completed an Adult Diploma Program with a minimum score of five out of 6 (gold) level on all three Work Keys assessments taken as part of the diploma.

**OR**

- Must have completed an Adult 22+ program with a minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA.
