A minimum grade of C- is required in all of the above listed courses to obtain a certificate.

* All incoming students will be required to provide ACT scores or take a placement test. Based on their scores, students will be placed in appropriate English and mathematics courses. Successful completion of developmental English, and mathematics prerequisites require a grade of C- or above in the course.
