The PHARMACY TECHNICIAN certificate is a one semester program and contains a sequence of courses that is taught in the fall or spring semester each year. Entrance into this certificate course is open to any student who has a desire to begin a path in the Pharmacy Technician profession. A minimum grade of C is required in all of the above listed courses to obtain a certificate.

* All incoming students will be required to provide ACT scores or take a placement test. Based on their scores, students will be placed in appropriate English and mathematics courses. Successful completion of developmental English, and mathematics prerequisites require a grade of C- or above in the course.
