- Complete your FREE online application at www.ncstatecollege.edu/apply.
- Supply transcript(s) from your high school, GED, or any college you've attended.
- Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) and request that a report be sent to North Central State College (code #005313).
- Have your ACT test scores reported to NC State (code #005313). If you haven't taken the ACT, schedule a free Accuplacer test at NC State.
- Schedule a time to attend orientation and meet with an advisor to complete your academic plan. They will help you enroll for your first term classes.
