Dear Dr. Diab:

The substantive change, i.e., addition and deletion of more than two courses; deletion of more than 10% of existing clock hours, for the associate degree radiography program sponsored by North Central State College was considered at the January 17, 2017 meeting of the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT). The JRCERT is the only agency recognized by the United States Department of Education (USDE) and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) for the accreditation of traditional and distance delivery educational programs in radiography, radiation therapy, magnetic resonance, and medical dosimetry. The JRCERT took the following action:

APPROVAL OF SUBSTANTIVE CHANGE.

This substantive change was effective January 17, 2017.

The current accreditation status of the program is eight (8) years. An interim report is required. The projected date for submission of the interim report is the First Quarter of 2017. Based on the interim report, the JRCERT will determine if the accreditation award of eight (8) years will be maintained or reduced and the continuing accreditation process expedited.

If the accreditation award is maintained, the next site visit is tentatively scheduled for the First Quarter of 2021.

The program is advised that consistent with JRCERT Policy 11.600, the JRCERT reserves the right to conduct unannounced site visits of accredited programs. The sponsoring institution would be responsible for the expenses of any on-site evaluation.
