Attention is given to the reasoning behind major tax regulations and their effects upon the business firm and the impact of tax regulations upon managerial decision-making.	Section 920 Online

Qualifications: Master's degree in accounting, or master's degree in related field with 18 semester hours completed in accounting beyond principles, or master's degree in related field with two of the following: in-field professional certification or professional employment or relevant additional training equivalent to 18 semester hours of CEU's, military training, vendor training, etc.

Minimum requirements are bachelor's degree in accounting and two or more of the following: in-field professional certification or in-field professional employment or teaching experience or in-field research and publication or relevant additional training equivalent to 18 semester hours of CEU's, military training, vendor training, etc.
