Course	Schedule	Course Description
<b>ITEC-1620-30</b> <b>Wireshark 101</b>	<b>Monday/Wednesday</b> <b>7:30 PM – 8:50 PM</b> <b>Kehoe Center, Shelby</b>	This course provides a starting point for analyzing network traffic, troubleshooting network performance, and detecting network security related incidents. Students will capture, filter, and analyze network traffic based on network protocols, applications, and data origin.
<b>ITEC-1610-900</b> <b>IT Essentials</b>	<b>Tuesday</b> <b>3:00 PM – 4:50 PM</b> <b>Kehoe Center, Shelby</b>	This course covers the fundamentals of computer hardware and software as well as more advanced concepts such as security, networking, and the responsibilities of an information and communications technology (ICT) professional. The curriculum helps students prepare for entry-level ICT career opportunities and the CompTIA A+ certification.
<b>ITEC-2660-01</b> <b>Cisco CCNA-Wireless</b>	<b>Monday &amp; Wednesday</b> <b>10:00 AM – 11:50 AM</b> <b>Kehoe Center, Shelby</b>	This course covers the installation and management of Cisco wireless platforms and solutions and involves installing, configuring, operating, and troubleshooting wireless networks. The course follows a logical organization of the CCNA Wireless exam objectives. Material is presented in a concise manner focusing on increasing the student's retention and recall of exam topics. This course, together with ITEC1635 prepares students for Cisco's CCNA - Wireless certification. Exam: 200-355 WIFUND

**Required Qualifications:** Master's degree preferred in computer science, information science, computer information systems, or a closely related field. Minimum requirement is a bachelor's degree in computer science, information science, computer information systems, or a bachelor's degree in a related discipline and comparable combination of course work and relevant professional experience. Certification in Information Technology areas, (ex. A+, Security+, Linux+, Cisco-CCNA, VMWare, EC-Council, Microsoft Server) and/or willingness to obtain required certifications within three years, or industry certification and three years relevant experience.
