- Maintain floor surfaces and coverings using manual and power equipment (e.g., buffers, shampooers, vacuums, extractors) to sweep, mop, scrub, strip, wax, polish, and shampoo floors and carpets
- Clean and sanitize classrooms, offices, restrooms, and common areas, including walls, doors, windows, air vents, mirrors, whiteboards, and fixtures
- Dust, wax, and polish furniture; shampoo upholstered furniture as needed
- Thoroughly clean and disinfect restrooms, including sinks, toilets, urinals, and dispensers; replenish supplies as needed
- Empty, clean, and sanitize waste and recycling containers and properly dispose of contents
- Prepare and use cleaning solutions safely according to specifications
- Clean light fixtures and other detailed or high areas as assigned
- Move and arrange furniture and equipment for room setups, events, and daily operations
- Inspect fire exits to ensure they are clean, clear, and free of obstructions
- Secure facilities by locking doors and windows as directed
- Observe and report maintenance needs, unsafe conditions, vandalism, or security concerns
- Maintain a clean, organized supply closet and notify the supervisor of supply needs
- Care for assigned equipment and report malfunctions or repair needs promptly
- Perform other related duties as assigned
