North Central State College is seeking adjunct faculty to teach the following courses for Summer semester 2024, beginning May 27, 2024.

<p>Intermediate Concepts in Nursing II (RNUR 1070) This intermediate course utilizes and builds on basic skills and knowledge of RNUR 1010 and 1050. The focus of study is on the utilization of the nursing process emphasized in classroom and clinical experiences as it relates to meeting basic human needs. Acute care units in the hospital setting are utilized for clinical rotation to integrate intermediate medical-surgical theory with practice. Students in this course have learned all of the medical surgical skills required as well as passing pharmacology. Skills are related to medication administration guidelines/techniques/calculations, IV assessment and calculations, OR protocols and procedures pre-, intra- and post-operative care, pain assessment & management, teaching and learning, and cognitive development with a focus on critical thinking. Emphasis is placed on interviewing and physical assessment skills; safe, hygienic client care; skills performance; emotional, spiritual, and cultural concerns; infection control, surgical wound healing, medical and surgical asepsis and excretory stressors.
