Course	Location Available
<p>Fundamentals of Practical Nursing (PNUR2012C)</p> <p>This course builds on the basic nursing knowledge gained in PNUR1012 and PNUR1030. Emphasis is placed upon content relating to interferences with meeting basic human needs of safety and protection, nutrition and elimination, sensory perception, and oxygenation throughout the life cycle. Focus will be upon utilization of the nursing process. Content includes presentation and study of drug categories that are related to common health problems. The role of the practical nurse in drug administration is emphasized. Principles of therapeutic nutrition are integrated throughout the course. Practical application of this information is achieved through clinical experience at acute care facilities.</p>	<p>Ohio Health Mansfield (3)</p> <p>Saturdays: 6:30 am to 5:00 pm</p> <p>8 students only</p> <p>Dates are: August 31, Sept. 7, 14, 21, 28, Oct. 5, 12.</p>
<p>Fundamentals of Practical Nursing (PNUR1012C)</p> <p>Course Description: This introductory course begins the study of the nursing process as it relates to meeting basic human needs of individuals in all age groups. Emphasis is placed upon principles of nursing care, performance of safe nursing measures, development of observational skills, and recording. Communication methods and nurse-patient relationships, health and health care organizations, and the role of the practical nurse as a member of the health care team are explored. Emphasis is placed upon increasingly complex principles of nursing care and performance of safe nursing measures as the semester progresses. First three weeks are in the lab and then move to the acute care units in the hospital setting are utilized for clinical rotation to integrate medical-surgical nursing theory with practice.</p>	<p>Avita, Galion</p> <p>Wednesdays only: 630 am to 1:30 pm</p> <p>8 students only</p> <p>Begins on Wednesday September 4th and runs through Wednesday November 20th.</p>
<p>Fundamentals of Practical Nursing (PNUR2032C)</p> <p>This course will continue the application of nursing care concepts, critical thinking, and contributions to the planning, implementation and evaluation of nursing care across the client life span, including Maternal Health Care. Students will continue to build upon the basic nursing knowledge gained in previous course work. Focus is placed on using the Nursing process within basic human needs, restoration of wellness, therapeutic communication, health maintenance and promotion. Students will apply the roles and responsibilities of the developing nurse in collaboration with the RN and/ or Health Care Provider.
