## 3357:13-12-20 Program Integrity/Assessment Framework Policy

- (A) It is the policy of the college that all communication of program curricular changes, program requirements, and all recruiting material be accurate, current, and communicated in a clear fashion. Any deliberate inaccuracies in material for the purpose of defrauding the public will be sanctioned and any employee participating in such activities, will be dismissed and could be subject to prosecution.
- (B) Coordination between all academic units and the marketing / admissions departments must be formalized at least once per academic year to assure print/web material accuracy.
- (C) The Academic Integrity/Assessment Framework of the college is organized as follows:
  - (1) Three committees make up the Academic /Assessment Framework:
    - (a) Assessment Committee (3357:13-12-21),
    - (b) Institutional Service and Program Review Committee (3357:13-12-22),
    - (c) Curriculum Committee (3357:13-12-23).
  - (2) The Assessment Committee supports and guides faculty and staff as they create program/department outcomes, and assess student learning within their areas.
  - (3) The Institutional Service and Program Review Committee supports and guides faculty and staff as they evaluate the efficacy and fiscal stability of their programs and departments.
  - (4) The Curriculum Committee is responsible for the curriculum change process.
  - (5) Each committee within the Academic Integrity/Assessment Framework has its own policies and processes; yet together, they are responsible for the integrity of the main products for which the college is known: The curriculum within the programs and the teaching, learning, and student support that happens in and outside of the classroom.
