

3357:12-21 Assessment of Student Learning Policy (Assessment Committee)

- (A) Assessment of student learning represents an ongoing, systematic approach to establishing clear and measurable goals for learning. North Central State College supports student learning assessment as a means of understanding and improving student learning and remaining aligned with regional stakeholder expectations.
- (B) Information on student learning will be gathered, analyzed, and interpreted for continuous improvement of teaching and learning. The assessment of student learning may be at the course, program, or institutional level.
- (C) One or more of the college-wide outcomes will be assessed in each of the following co-curricular activities: Honors College, Phi Theta Kappa, Sigma Alpha Pi, Psi Beta and TRIO. Each area will select the college wide outcome rubric that best aligns with its activities.
- (D) Assessment fosters effective student learning, curriculum enhancement, and program development, and contributes to resource allocation decisions. The assessment of student learning is a college-wide responsibility and is guided by the Chief Academic Officer and the assessment committee.
