3357:13-13-32 Articulation Credit Policy (High School)

- (A) Students in selected programs in area high schools and career centers may receive advanced standing in North Central State College programs. This is initiated through an articulation agreement between North Central State College and the high school or career center. These agreements are reviewed annually. For further information on a particular agreement, contact the Admissions Office.
- (B) Students seeking articulation credit must (1) submit an application to North Central State College within two years of high school graduation, (2) request articulation credit by completing the form available in the North Central State College Office of Student Records or online, and (3) submit an official high school transcript to the North Central State College Office of Student Records.
- (C) In addition to the Articulation Agreements described above, various special arrangements exist regarding credit-by-examination available to vocational and tech-prep graduates under certain circumstances. Details can be found in the articulation documents signed by representatives of North Central State College and the respective schools.
