

3357:13-13-34 Life Experience Credit Policy

- (A) In some curricular areas, it is the policy of the College to recognize competencies acquired through life/work experience that have no external test as proof of outcome attainment.
- (B) In order to qualify, interested persons must apply for Life Experience Credit. Students will contact the appropriate Assistant Dean to determine availability of life experience credit within their degree program. A student must translate life and/or work experience into competencies, match competencies with what is specified in the course outcomes, and display these materials in a “portfolio.”
- (C) Students applying for Life/Work Experience Credit must have five full years of relevant experience. Portfolios are evaluated by faculty and/or external reviewers with expertise in the field.
- (D) Students seeking credit for life experience will follow the procedures described in the current catalog.
- (E) Life Experience Credit Faculty Compensation: Faculty advising a student or reviewing a portfolio for life experience credit will be compensated in accordance with the current AAUP contract.
