

3357:13:14-26 Course Grading Policy and Required Grading Scale

- (A) North Central State College uses the standard 4.00 point scale letter grade system (with pluses and minuses). Faculty will issue a grade to each student at the mid-point in the term and then again at the end of the term.
- (B) An earned letter grade is issued to each student at the end of the term based on a set of criteria defined in the course syllabus. All faculty are required to use the North Central State College required grading scale when issuing letter grades.
