

3357:13:14-27 Mid-Term Course Grading Policy

- (A) North Central State College (NCSC) requires that at the mid-point of an academic course, students enrolled in that course be notified of their progress. A letter grade will be calculated based on the work completed at the mid-way point in the term.
- (B) NCSC uses the standard 4.00 letter grade system (with pluses and minuses). Faculty will issue a grade to each student at the mid-point in the term and then again at the end of the term. Mid-term grades are not recorded in any permanent record or on a student's academic transcript.
- (C) Mid-term grades provide students with early feedback (both positive and negative) about their academic performance. Mid-term grades provide an opportunity for students to receive positive reinforcement and motivation if they are doing well, and intervention if they are struggling. Mid-semester grades allow faculty, advisors and other service providers on campus to intervene with students who are in academic difficulty, while there is still time to make improvement.
