

3357:13:14-28 Cumulative Grading System Policy

- (A) North Central State College uses the standard 4.00 point scale letter grade system (with pluses and minuses). A student must earn at least a 2.00 grade point average to graduate.
- (B) The grade-point-average is the arithmetic mean of the grade points earned for all credits taken at North Central State College for college credit, regular grades are awarded. For repeated courses, only the most recent grade and credit is used towards computing the grade point average.
- (C) In calculating the Grade-Point Average, the quality-hour value for each course is multiplied by the number of quality points for that grade. (Quality-hours are those hours earned from courses with A, B, C, D, or F grades.) This sum is then divided by the sum of the quality hours. See procedure 14-281 for details on calculating the grade-point average.
