

3357:13-14-31 Grade Replacement Policy

(A) A student may retake a course as many times as he/she wishes. Only the most recently earned percentage or P/NP grade will count in the student's accumulative average. However, an indication that the student attempted the course more than once will remain on the transcript. This policy does not alter any departmental policies on academic dismissal.

(B) This policy was adopted in 1985 and is not retroactive. Consequently, any courses completed prior to the Summer Quarter 1985 will continue to appear on the student transcript and be counted in the accumulative average. Exceptions can be requested from the Vice President for Academic Services.
