

3357:13-14-66 Academic Honesty/Dishonesty

- (A) It is the position of the College that the responsibility for academic honesty is that of the student. It is expected that the student's work will be the product of his/her own efforts, unless the student clearly indicates otherwise. Academic honesty is an important element of mature, responsible learning. It is recognized by the College that the prime responsibility for academic honesty belongs to the individual student; however, the instructor will try to create a learning environment that discourages cheating and encourages honest scholarship.
