

3357:13-17-302 Expenditure of Public Funds for Food and Beverages

Purpose:

- (A) To promote the public health, safety, morals, general welfare, security, prosperity, and general good of all the inhabitants of North Central State College.
- (B) In order to effectively and efficiently promote the College's business, outreach activities, training of employees, and functions that serve a proper public purpose.
- (C) The College may expend public funds to purchase coffee, meals, refreshments, and other amenities for its officers, employees, or other persons.
- (D) The College does not view the expenditure of public funds for alcoholic beverages as a proper public purpose.
- (E) Functions that would serve a proper public purpose would include, but are not limited to:
 - (1) Employee recognition dinner
 - (2) Board of Trustees' dinner
 - (3) Public coffees
 - (4) Advisory Committee meetings
 - (5) Department meetings
 - (6) Faculty and staff meetings
 - (7) Professional development activities
