3357:13-17-302 Expenditure of Public Funds for Food and Beverages

Purpose:

(A) To promote the public health, safety, morals, general welfare, security, prosperity, and

general good of all the inhabitants of North Central State College.

(B) In order to effectively and efficiently promote the College's business, outreach activities,

training of employees, and functions that serve a proper public purpose.

(C) The College may expend public funds to purchase coffee, meals, refreshments, and other

amenities for its officers, employees, or other persons.

(D) The College does not view the expenditure of public funds for alcoholic beverages as a

proper public purpose.

(E) Functions that would serve a proper public purpose would include, but are not limited to:

(1) Employee recognition dinner

(2) Board of Trustees' dinner

(3) Public coffees

(4) Advisory Committee meetings

(5) Department meetings

(6) Faculty and staff meetings

(7) Professional development activities
