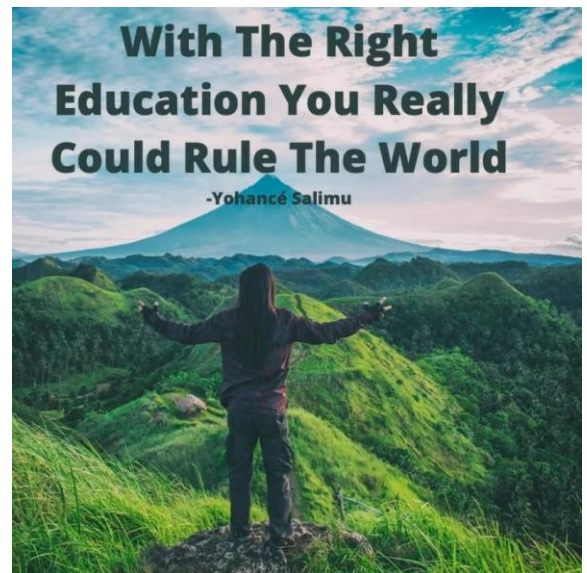


YOU ARE IN THE RIGHT PLACE!
