

3357:13-13-03 Policy on General Education

The following definition of general education and credit hour requirements for general education (as set forth by the Ohio Board of Regents) has been adopted as the official policy of the college for all associate degree programs.

(A) Definition: "General education is 'general' in several clearly identifiable ways: it is not directly related to a student's formal, technical, vocational, or professional preparations; it is a part of every student's course of study, regardless of his or her area of emphasis; it is intended to impart common knowledge, intellectual concepts, and attitudes that every educated person should possess."

(B) Credit Hour Requirements: (Universal requirements for an Associate Degree)

(1) Three semester credit hours of English Composition (one course)

(2) Three semester credit hours of Mathematics (one course).

(3) Three semester credit hours (one course) in TWO of the following area:

(a) Arts and Humanities

(b) Social and Behavioral Sciences

(c) Natural Sciences

(4) Three additional semester credit hours in one of the following area:

(a) English Composition and Oral Communications area

(b) Mathematics and Data Analysis area

(c) Arts and Humanities area

(d) Social and Behavioral Sciences or Natural Sciences
