

3357:13:14-28 Cumulative Grading System Policy

- (A) North Central State College uses the standard 4.00 point scale letter grade system (with pluses and minuses). A student must earn at least a 2.00 grade point average to graduate.
- (B) The grade-point-average is the arithmetic mean of the grade points earned for all credits taken at North Central State College for college credit, regular grades are awarded.
- (C) In calculating the Grade-Point Average, the quality-hour value for each course is multiplied by the number of quality points for that grade. (Quality-hours are those hours earned from courses with A, B, C, D, or F grades.) This sum is then divided by the sum of the quality hours. See procedure 14-281 for details on calculating the grade-point average.
