{OCTOBER 1-31: Student Advising & Planning Month for Spring Courses}

Before November, check-in with your advisor to update your Pathway and MyNC course plan by term as needed, and secure advisor approval to register for your next term. **With advisor pre-approval in MyNC**, you can register for your next term as early as 8AM on first day of registration for "Undeclared" majors. {NOVEMBER 5: MyNC Spring Course Registration OPENS for Current CCP Students; NOV. 6 for New}

During the active registration window, use MyNC to confirm you've selected a section (when/where the course meets) for each approved course. Then select 'Register Now' to register for *all* approved courses in your plan. Or select 'Register' under each approved course to register for one at a time.

{MARCH is STUDENT ADVISING AND PLANNING MONTH:}

BEFORE APRIL - check-in with your advisor to update your Pathway and MyNC term course plan as needed, and secure advisor approval to register for your next term in CCP. **With advisor pre-approval in MyNC**, you are ready register for classes through MyNC as early as 8AM on the on first day of registration for "Undeclared" majors. APRIL 8 - In MyNC SUMMER & FALL COURSE REGISTRATION GOES LIVE (Current CCP Students)

APR 9 – REG. goes live for New CCP Students

***YOU MUST use MYNC to finalize YOUR COURSE REGISTRATION during this time.** Only then will you have a seat in the course. Confirm you've selected a section (when class meets) for each approved course. Then select 'Register Now' to register at once for your entire approved term plan at once. Or to register for one at a time, select 'Register' under each approved course.

Important – Course Drop vs. Course Withdrawal ("W")

DAY 1 to DAY 14 of the TERM: CCP No-Penalty Drop Period - CCP Students may drop a course without penalty BEFORE 5PM ON THIS DEADLINE. Student must submit the drop request to ccp@ncstatecollege.edu with school counselor included on the email.

DAY 1 is - THE FIRST DATE OF THE TERM IN WHICH THE COURSE IS RUNNING: _____
DAY 14 is – TWO WEEKS LATER BY 5PM: _____

Courses taken at NCSC or Online, DAY 1 is the start date of NCSC's TERM.

Courses taken at the High School, DAY 1 is the start date of your HIGH SCHOOL'S TERM.

Example - If NCSC's term starts Mon. Aug. 11 (DAY 1), then DAY 14 would be Mon. Aug. 25 (by 5PM)
If the High School starts back Wed. Aug. 20 (DAY 1), then DAY 14 would be Wed. Sep. 3 (by 5PM)

DAY 15 to the LAST DAY TO WITHDRAW with a "W" - During this window, a CCP student can be withdrawn from a course and will receive a grade of "W". This shows a course attempt on your transcript but does not impact on your GPA.

*Your school district may charge you for tuition costs from courses with a grade of "W" or "F".

AFTER THE LAST DATE TO WITHDRAW ("W") for the TERM - NO COURSE WITHDRAWAL REQUESTS ARE ACCEPTED.

ACADEMIC UNDERPERFORMANCE in CCP: If your college cGPA is less than 2.0, or if you receive two "F"s or "W"s in the same term, your CCP participation may be subject to Probation or Dismissal (as determined by your school district).
