



Finding Important Course Information (Book ISBN Numbers/Course Drop, Refund, and Withdrawal Dates)

Step 1: Go to www.ncstatecollege.edu and scroll down to the Course Search tile. Click on this link.



Step 2: From here, make sure to choose the correct semester for the courses you are searching.



Step 3: You can search for one course at a time or all of them at once. Start by clicking the drop down menu under Subjects. You will then choose the area of discipline of your course. Next, fill in the 4 digit Course Number and the Section number. These can be found on your Registration Statement or within your MyNC account. Here is an example: BUSM-1010-920. Once all the information is filled in, click Submit.

Step 4: Your course(s) will show up with blue hyperlinks. Click on each hyperlink to bring up the course information.

Step 5: Here you can find:

- Start and end dates of a course.
- Last day you can withdraw from a course (at a certain point within the semester, you are not able to withdraw and will receive a grade).
- The 100% refund and 50% refund periods (each date is the last day you are able to drop the course to receive the respective refund). If you drop a course after these dates, you will be responsible for the entire cost. Your financial aid is a separate aspect to this and may be impacted based on any drop regardless if it is within a refund period or not. It is always best to consult with the Financial Aid office before dropping a class to see how it impacts your aid and your total amount due. **Note: if you never login/attend a course, you will not be charged for it.**
- Your Book ISBN number. With this, you can search for your book materials outside of our institution's bookstore. **Make sure that if the book requires a digital access code that you buy this along with the book. Also, some courses require multiple books. Make sure you purchase each required book/resource needed for each course.**
