

### SPRING 2022 JOB & INTERSHIP FAIR

Welcome to the Spring 2022 semester. As you prepare for the spring term, you should also begin thinking about your career goals. This is a great opportunity for you to network and connect with employers for jobs and internships as well as explore different career fields.

At the fair each company representative will have a table set up to talk with interested students who wish to learn more about the company or those interested in applying for specific roles. An interaction with an employer at the fair is often no more than 2-5 minutes, and is a chance for an introductory conversation, for you to express your interest in the employer, and often for you to share your resume with them.

#### Prepare for the Fair:

- 1) Pre-registration is highly recommended (watch your email for the link as the event date approaches).
- 2) Review and research the organizations that will be attending.
- 3) Decide which companies you would like to meet with.
- 4) Prepare and print copies of your resume (attend a Resume Workshop or contact Career Services for help).
- 5) Create and prepare your elevator pitch.
- 6) Prepare your attire (professional dress is recommended – visit the campus Career Closet for free clothing)


