

STUDYING TIPS BASED ON LEARNING STYLES:

AUDITORY LEARNERS:

- Explain the material to someone.
- Read explanations out loud.
- Make up a song using the subject material, the crazier the better.
- Make up and repeat rhymes to remember facts, dates, names, etc.
- Go over all important facts aloud.
- Join a study group or get a study partner.
- Use mnemonics and word links.
- Have a discussion related to the material.

TACTILE LEARNERS:

- Pick up the book while reading.
- Write while you are reading or talking.
- Use rhythm (beats) to memorize or explain something.
- Make models that demonstrate the key concept.
- Make flashcards for each step in the procedure.
- Use gestures when explaining.
- Stand/move while explaining something to a study buddy.
- Use hands-on experience when possible.

VISUAL LEARNERS:

- Take notes.
- Use a blackboard or notepaper to write questions and answers.
- Use color-coded highlighting.
- Use mnemonics, acronyms, visual chains, and mind maps.
- Make flashcards.
- Visualize the scene, formula, words, charts; etc.
- Use the computer to organize materials, to create graphs, tables, charts, and spreadsheets.
- Use visual analogies and/or metaphors.
- Use photographs and/or illustrations.
