

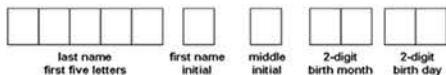
All NC State Student accounts will be already setup for you.

Username

Student username will consist of the following:

- The first five letters of your last name
- Followed by your first initial
- Followed by your middle initial
- Followed by the month you were born (using two digits)
- Followed by the day you were born (also using two digits)

For example: The login for a student named Jessica Ann Monroe, with a birth date of September 8th would be: monroja0908. Office 365, My Password Services, and MyNC login in with email.



To login to Office 365, Canvas, and MyNC. You will use the following format:

Username@mail.ncstatecollege.edu

Synchronized Password

All student passwords are synchronized for Canvas, Office 365 Email, My Password Services, Desktop Login, WiFi, and MyNC and will consist of the following:

- NCSC
- First two letters of your first name (capitalized)
- Followed by the last four of your social security number
- Followed by the first two letters of your last name (lower case).

For example: The password for Jessica Ann Monroe would be: NCSCJE1234mo

Mobility Printing

With Mobility Printing you can print from your wireless device whether it is a phone, laptop, or tablet on campus. First, connect to NC State's wireless network using **NCSC Secure** with your wireless device. (Use the same username and password that you use to log into MyNC.) Then click on the **Mobility Printing** link found on the Pay to Print webpage and download the driver or app to your device. Mobility video instructions are on the webpage.

Password Services

You will now be required to change your NC State password every 365 days. To maintain your synchronized login, passwords can only be changed through **Password Services** or by calling the IT Service Desk at 419-755-4734 if you are unable to log into Password Services.

You can access this tool by clicking on **Menu** from our home page then click on **Password Services**. Password Services login will be the same as your standard username and password that you use to log in to Canvas. Choose **NC Student** from the "Log In" drop down menu. To enroll in Password Services, log in and choose the Enrollment tab (top left). Fill out all the security questions. Once you have enrolled in Password Services, the system will automatically send you a reminder email a few days prior to your password expiring.

Password Requirements

Must be at least 12 characters long and contain 3 out of 4 elements: upper case, lower case, numbers, or special characters. You cannot use more than 2 characters of your name.

Canvas

Canvas is NC State's state of the art web learning platform to allow you to participate in online or hybrid classes, as well as offer you access to online materials and activities to complement your face-to-face class experience.

Canvas can give you access to your latest grades, due dates, assignments, electronic course materials, discussion boards, chat and more.

You can access NC State's Canvas server directly at: <https://ncstate.instructure.com/login/ldap> or from the top right corner of our home page, click on **Menu**, then **Canvas**.

You will have access to your NC State online or hybrid courses by 8am the first day of the semester. For traditional courses please see your instructor for a publish date.

MyNC

MyNC offers academic planning, class schedules, grades, financial aid records, course search, degree audits, and class registration from one centralized location.

Lab Computer Login

You will be required to log in to all lab computers. Use the same user to log in to the lab computers as you do for Canvas.

Office 365 for Students

NC State College offers enrolled students a free subscription to Microsoft Office 365 with their student email account at no cost. Each student can install a full free version of Office 365 on up to five devices including desktop, laptop, tablets, or mobile devices (Mac or PC) **for as long as you attend NC State College.**

Office 365 Benefits:

- Student email account with 50 GB of email storage & can be accessed through mobile devices.
- Office online and mobile applications.
- 1 TB of OneDrive storage to store and access your documents from the cloud.
- Includes latest version of Word, Excel, PowerPoint, OneNote, Access, and Outlook.
- Available for all enrolled students. Your account will be deactivated if you do not attend a semester.

Office 365 & Student Email Access

You can access your student Office 365 account from the **Current Students** webpage or through any standard web browser at: <https://login.microsoftonline.com>

To log in, use your entire email address as the username.

Your email address will be your username@mail.ncstatecollege.edu. For example: monroja0908@mail.ncstatecollege.edu. Your password will be the same one you use for MyNC.

Please note: Office 365 is the ONLY program that will require you to use your entire email address to log in.

Secure Wireless Internet

NCSC Secure is a secured faster wireless connection for employees and students with more bandwidth and requires your login credentials. Students may connect to NCSC Secure by using the same login credentials that they use for their MyNC login.

NC State College's Computer & Network Policy and Wireless Access Policy

NC State NEW RFID Cards Required

You will be required to obtain a new RFID (radio frequency identification) card from the cashier's office located in Byron Kee Center room 140. These cards will look the same as your last ID card except on the back there will not be a bar code strip. RFID cards will be required to use our printers and to enter buildings.

Pay to Print

A student print fee will be implemented to recover the escalating costs of printing and is consistent with the other public computing facilities within our state.

Semester Pre-Load

Each semester, registered students will receive \$5.00 automatically loaded on their student ID card for printing. This equates to 100 black and white one-sided copies. You will need to add additional money to your Student ID card once the \$5.00 is used.
