

CCP APPLICANTS: ARE YOU TAKING ACCUPLACER WITH NCSC?

- 1) **Apply:** Make sure you have a [submitted application to NCSC](#). (A NCSC application is valid for 1 yr, if not enrolled.)
- 2) **Review Test Dates:** *Space is limited. Check the [NCSC Testing Center Calendar for upcoming ACCUPLACER sessions](#).
 - a. Your first ACCUPLACER test with NCSC is free.
 - b. To retest, pay a \$25 retest fee [by phone to the Cashier's Office – 419-755-7722](#) at least 24 hours before testing.
- 3) **Reserve Appointment:** Space is limited. Call to reserve a seat for an upcoming test: 419-755-4536 (Main Campus)
If seeking to test at the Crawford Center, call to inquire: 419-755-9039
- 4) **Prepare:** *[Review & Practice](#)
([Reading](#), [WritePlacer Essay](#) & [Adv. Algebra](#) are the NCSC-administered tests for CCP.)
 - a. Confirm directions to the testing location. [Virtual campus tour](#)
 - b. Plan to arrive 15 minutes before your appointment to complete check-in.
 - c. At check-in, students are asked to provide photo ID, or other personally identifiable info.
- 5) **After Testing:** Go to [ACCUPLACER's student portal](#) and request your score report.
 - a. ACCUPLACER will ask you to confirm your info to provide access to your scores.
 - b. Share scores with other colleges through ACCUPLACER's student portal

Testing or Test Optional for CCP?

Is testing required to take CCP courses with NCSC? [This depends on two things:](#)

- (1) Your HS GPA (unweighted)
- (2) Which courses you wish to take. (See Table A.)

- ✓ **If your GPA qualifies you for CCP eligibility**, [and your desired CCP courses are not Math or English](#), nor have a placement requirement or pre-req. to register, [then you might not need to test](#). Confirm w/ your advisor.
- ✓ **For 12th grade CCP students** (Multiple Measures), You [may](#) have successfully completed high school coursework, which [could qualify you for direct course placement](#) into college English or Math, [without testing](#).
For this, provide CCP@ncstatecollege.edu with a HS transcript showing your final grades for 11th and cGPA.

College Admission:	All admission requirements must be completed by the college deadlines. (Some colleges require test scores for admission, regardless of GPA. NCSC does not.)	Each college
Course Planning & Registration:	All prerequisites or placement requirements must be met. (Testing for course placement may be needed, independent of CCP program eligibility.)	Each college

Testing or Test Optional for CCP?

Is testing required to take CCP courses with NCSC? This depends on two things:
